Rendezvous: In vicinity of Region 2 Chesapeake Bay Area Mark "T" (Baltimore Light).

Start: Between yellow flag on RC boat and nearby inflatable or government mark. All yachts must start within 30 minutes of their starting time. A yacht in the starting area other than at her authorized time can expect to be protested by the RC.

Finish: Between yellow flag **at northwest corner of Tide Point promenade in Baltimore Inner Harbor (N39°16'34.2", W076°35'31.2") and nearby inflatable mark.** Course may be shortened at any designated mark.

Course: Designated by letters on RC boat using Region 2 Standard Racing Marks, **as well as finish mark at Tide Point promenade (to be designated Mark "X").** If conditions permit, the course will be set for at least 20 nautical miles. The RC boat will monitor VHF Channel 72. **NOTE:** Be aware of rocky shoals close to Mark "N" (Forward Craighill Channel Light) as indicated on the Region 2 Standard Racing Marks pages in this Greenbook.

Time Limit: 6 hours.

Protests

Rule 61.1(a) is changed by adding: “a boat displaying a red flag and intending to protest shall inform the race committee as soon as possible after finishing by hail or VHF call on the fleets broadcast channel 72 until acknowledged. The hail shall include the sail number or name of the protested boat. Submit written protest form to RC Chairman, or representative, at site of the post race party within one hour of last yacht to finish. Protests heard as soon as possible after the race.

Awards

1st/3; 2nd/5; 3rd/7; 4th/10. Trophies will be awarded at the post-race party for classes that have final results.
