The "Nearshore Category" of the US Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements (SER), available a <u>US Sailing.org</u> , will apply.
Rendezvous:	At 1800 in vicinity of BCYA Mark H, "Y Can B", N 39° 14.969' W 76° 33.145'. The Race Committee may broadcast via VHF 72 its position at a different BCYA mark. Die Hard Series rendezvous time is modified to 1745.
First Warning	g: 1825 hours for Series 1, 2, and 3. 1815 hours for Series 4. 1750 hours for the Die Hard Series.
Radio:	Boats should monitor VHF 72 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee (RC).
Start:	The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the RC boat and the course side of a nearby inflatable or government mark.

Finish:	The finishing line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the RC boat and the last mark of the course.
